

**Under-utilized Space Memorandum**  
***As of October 6, 2010***

The Department of Education (DOE) has preliminarily determined that 224 schools located in 119 buildings are “under-utilized.” This designation is primarily based upon the 2009-2010 Enrollment-Capacity-Utilization Report (The Blue Book). Other factors are noted below.

In cases where there are multiple buildings on a school campus, Blue Book capacity and enrollment figures have been combined and presented as totals. Additionally, the list of schools determined “under-utilized” is subject to amendment based on further analysis.

The DOE has asked principals to review this determination with their School Leadership Teams (SLT) and provide any feedback to inform future decisions about potential changes to your space and building.

Building space is scarce in many New York City neighborhoods. Given this reality and the growing enrollment needs of our 1.1 million students, we must use our existing public buildings in the most efficient manner possible. We must also work to ensure that students and families in every community have high-quality educational options.

To this end, each year the DOE’s Division of Portfolio Planning (Portfolio) publishes and requests school and community feedback on space utilization information and potential changes. This is a transparent process that applies consistent rules to all school buildings and considers school and community feedback prior to any decision-making.

**It is important to note that a school’s inclusion in the list of under-utilized buildings does not signify that a change will be made for the 2011-2012 school year. A school’s inclusion is simply the first step in sharing information on space utilization and discussing potential ways of using space more efficiently.**

Options for usage of excess space include, but are not limited to, the following:

- The addition of new educational programs (e.g. Pre-Kindergarten, Gifted & Talented, D75, D79, Special Education classes)
- Expansion of existing programs
- Grade expansion
- Enrollment changes, including re-zoning neighboring schools to optimize the distribution of students
- Temporary or permanent co-location of one or more new schools

Final decisions will be based on a number of factors, including: feedback from SLTs, the amount of space available, local enrollment needs, the need for new school options, and available funding (where applicable). Alternatively, Portfolio may determine that no change is needed or possible for the upcoming school year. Pursuant to the Education Law, any proposed significant change in school utilization will be subject to public notice and public hearing requirements, and must be approved by the Panel for Educational Policy prior to implementation.

Outlined below are the basic guidelines used to determine which schools are included on this list:

Criteria for initial inclusion:

- Minimum of 300 seats currently available – per the 2009-2010 Blue Book
- **OR**
- Minimum of 300 seats projected to be available over the next 2-3 years (e.g., a current school in the building is phasing out)

Schools were removed from the list if:

- The projected number of available seats over the next 2-3 years is or will be less than 300 (e.g., one or more schools are in the midst of phasing into the building or part of a planned expansion).
- Unique classroom configurations or school architecture disallow for the minimum number of classrooms needed for a new school or program in the building (e.g., 'open classrooms').
- Full-size classrooms must be used for special education classes (D75 or District), serving a smaller than average number of children per classroom, and thereby reducing the number of available seats below 300.

Important Notes

- No space changes will be proposed without further consultation between Portfolio and you and your school community.
- Any proposed space change that involves the co-location of another school organization will require a site visit by the Division of School Facilities for an on-site review of the building.
- Any proposed space change that requires approval by the Panel for Education Policy will be preceded by a formal public notice and a public hearing held at the school, where community members can provide feedback on the proposal prior to the vote.
