Re: Notice of Revisions to School Charters

Dear Chancellor Klein:

Pursuant to my prior notice letter, this Notice, pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1), is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York will consider approval of the following proposed revisions at its next meeting, on October 26, 2007.

Amber Charter School: Decrease in enrollment from 460 students to 400 students for the 2007-08 school year; and from 460 to 425 for the remaining two years of its charter; and increase in dissolution reserve fund minimum to \$75,000.

Girls Preparatory Charter School of New York: Decrease in enrollment from 220 students to 177 students for the 2007-08 school year, and from 286 students to 214 students for the 2008-09 school year, and if facilities become available, increase enrollment to current charter levels; and increase in dissolution reserve fund minimum to \$75,000.

KIPP S.T.A.R. College Prep Charter School: Decrease in enrollment from 360 students to 303 students for the 2007-08 school year; and increase in dissolution reserve fund minimum to \$75,000.

Sisulu -Walker Charter School of Harlem: Increase its grades served from first through fourth grade for the 2007-08 school year, and second through fifth grade for the 2008-09 school year to kindergarten through fourth grade and first through fifth grade, respectively; and increase in dissolution reserve fund minimum to \$75,000.
