

Application Instructions

Please read carefully before completing your application

Eligibility: Students must reside in New York City at the time of application submission to be eligible for the District 25 grades 1 and 2 application process for the 2012-13 school year. Students must be born in 2006 to be eligible for 1st grade placement.

Admissions Priorities: Applicants will be admitted according to the following order of priority:

1. District 25 students who have a verified sibling* at one of the schools listed on the application will receive priority to the sibling's school.
2. Non-District 25 students who have a verified sibling* at one of the schools listed on the application will receive priority to the sibling's school.
3. All other District 25 students.
4. District 26 students applying to P.S. 130 The Early Childhood School for Science and Technology will receive priority to this school.
5. All other Non-District 25 students.

*All listed siblings are verified by the receiving school. For an applicant to qualify for sibling priority, the sibling must be currently enrolled in grades K-2 at the school at the time of application submission.

If there are more applicants within a priority group than available seats, seats will be offered through a random lottery.

Applicants are not guaranteed a placement at any of their requested schools. Students applying through this process are also encouraged to seek admission at their zoned school.

Submitting Your Application: Submit a separate application *in person* no later than **Friday, March 9, 2012** to each school you are interested in having your child attend in September 2012.
