- Demonstrated ability to successfully model lessons utilizing effective coaching techniques.
- Demonstrated excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated expertise in K-12 curriculum, instruction, and integration of tool and instructional software.
- Demonstrated ability to conduct technology workshops for a variety of participants including teachers and/or administrators.
